Earthshine Moon

Super Moon rise:

Earthshine is a dull glow which lights up the unlit part of the Moon because the Sun's light reflects off the Earth's surface and back onto the Moon.

Earthshine is best seen a few days before and after a New Moon, right after sunset or before sunrise. Earthshine is more intense in April and May.
